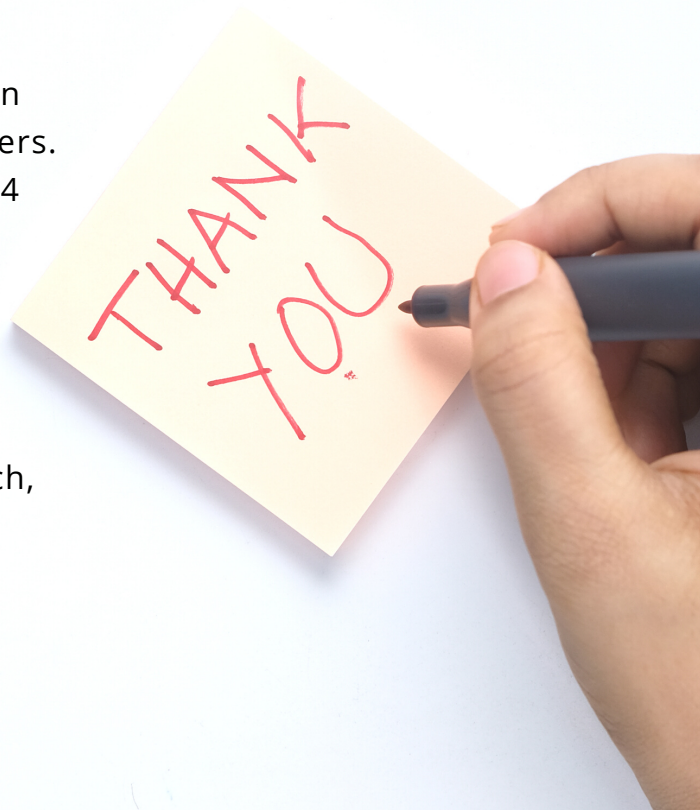


Scholarships
